



Treatment Foster Care Oregon
is an alternative to congregate care for youth with
severe emotional and behavioral problems



Readiness

TFCO Model:

Average length of treatment: 6-9 months

Team size: 10 homes, one youth per home

Pre-implementation includes expert assistance with agency feasibility and readiness, community engagement, cost calculator, and funding and model sustainability.

Critical components of TFCO:

- Highly trained and supported foster parents
- One TFCO youth in each home
- All treatment occurs within the TFCO team
- Simultaneous and intensive treatment for youth and aftercare family with school and community engagement
- TFCO uses an evidence-based implementation approach

Approximate Costs of TFCO:

Year one: \$74,440

Year two: \$43,020

Post-certification: \$10,190
(average annual cost)

Cost Savings:

TFCO has a demonstrated, long-term cost benefit!

For every \$1.00 spent on TFCO treatment compared to usual care, there is a benefit of \$3.15 at 4 ½ years, increasing to \$4.35 at 9 ½ years, when considering child welfare and criminal justice involvement.
